Information leaflet on visas and residence permits

- Stand 09/2017 -

General information:

Lithuanian citizens are subject to the free movement of persons within the European Union. Visas or resident permits are not needed any more. For longer-period stays in Germany European Union citizens have to register at the competent registry office (Einwohnermeldeamt) in Germany.

Citizens of Non-EU-Countries, living with a valid permanent residence permit or a category "D" visa in Lithuania can travel to Germany for visiting/business purposes for 90 days within 6 months without another visa.

To stay in Germany for more than 90 days within 6 months and / or working purposes it is not necessary to apply for a visa in advance, if the foreigner has one of the following Lithuanian residence permits:

- residence permit for family members of EU Member States' nationals - card acc. to Art. 10 sec. 1 Directive 2004/38/EC: „Europos Sąjungos valstybės narės piliečio šeimos nario leidimas gyventi Lietuvos Respublikoje“
- "long-term resident - EC" acc. to Council Directive 2003/109/EC: „ilgalaikis gyventojas - EB“

In any other cases an application for a residence permit has to be filed in the German Embassy in advance.

Application:

Application can be filed during the opening hours of the Embassy (see below), an appointment is not needed. Applications must be filed personally.

Duration:

Visa for the purpose of studying can usually be issued within 4 weeks. For other kinds of visa a processing time of up to a few months has to be calculated. Please consider this while planning your stay and application.

Necessary documents:

- two filled in and signed application forms
- valid passport (valid for at least six more months)
- residence permit for Lithuania (valid for at least three more months)
- 2 biometric passport photographs
- visa fee of 75 €
- health insurance (can be presented when picking up the visa)
- further documents depending on the purpose of stay (see below and next page)

All documents have to be presented in original version together with two simple copies. Documents which are not in German or English have to be presented with a certified translation by a notary.

- informal written declaration of the spouse / partner living in Germany, that he plans to live with the applicant in marital community in Germany
- copy of the German ID-card (front and back page) of the spouse / partner living in Germany, or:
- copy of the passport and registration document (Meldebescheinigung) of the spouse / partner living in Germany

- signed employment contract with the employer in Germany or concret job offer indicating the type and duration of work, working place and salary	- signed internship contract with the employer in Germany or concret internship offer indicating the type and duration of work, working place and salary - internship schedule, if not indicated in the contract - if no or not sufficient salary is paid, proof of financial means	- Business plan, i.e. a structured and detailed description of the business idea including capital requirements and capital budget, description of the company profile, marketing strategy and business forecast. - indication of the expected number of created jobs and / or training positions and explanation about the positive effects in the area of innovation and research. - documents to prove the capital budget
